Our JLPN crews look at loss in the form of little numbers becoming big numbers, that ultimately affect the financial health of the company at the end of the year. With another season coming on, we have seen steady and predictable sales in shade, flowering and ornamental. This year JLPN

is offering B-Grade field grown seedlings for land reclamation and reforestation productions. These plants are all viable and healthy, but do not adhere to guidelines of the ANLA standards for tree grades and suitability for the landscape (primarily the roots). They are a viable tree with a root and a top, that will survive if watered and handled properly.

B-Grades will HAVE:

- A viable root and top, meaning it will survive and grow
- A general grade for height or caliper, not both, and not exact
- Potentially forked or broken tops
- A root that could be J'd, forked, crooked, or Curly-Q'd
- A strong resemblance to the Charlie Brown Christmas Tree Pre-decoration
- To be ordered in quantities of 5,000 or more

B-Grades will possibly NOT:

- Meet ANLA standards
- Have root systems suitable for nursery landscape and retail market
- Have straight roots
- Have perfect leaders
- Have a chance of turning into the wonderful version Charlie Brown Christmas tree when it's all pretty and decorated
- Be sold in quantities less than 5,000

ROOTED CUTTINGS JUNES DESCRIPTION

JLPN sells many items by the piece, and not by size, due to the fact that the development of the root system is far more critical to a plants future growth than the height. To clarify the scale, we have provided the following pictures of 25 count, rooted cutting bundles. In all cases, JLPN delivers plants that are healthy and viable, however having two options gives the buyer a little flexibility on price, to fit their growing needs.

O" Rooted Cutting (R/C)



Not Advertised for Sale, zero's are just that, zero new growth. They are fully rooted, but only suitable for containers.

1"-3" Rooted Cutting (R/C)



1-3" of new growth, and fully rooted. Recommended for growing in container for 1 season, or fields with solid weed control practices.

4"+ Rooted Cutting (R/C)



4"+ of new growth, and fully rooted. All R/C's are topped at a max height of 16". Roots are going to be larger, more durable, and more developed. All plants listed "R/C" are field ready, for transplanting.
